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Supplement 1. The administered questionnaire on sexual function.

- 1. How often have you had sexual thoughts (desire) of any kind, e.g. wish for sexual intercourse in the past 6 months/6 months before the onset of the renal disease? (Response alternatives: several times a week, 1 or more times per month, <1 time/month, never)
- 2. How often did you take the initiative for sexual activities in the past 6 months/6 months before the onset of the renal disease? (Response alternatives: several times a week, 1 or more times per month, <1 time/month, never)
- 3. How often did you have sexual intercourse in the past 6 months/6 months before the onset of the renal disease? (Response alternatives: several times a week, 1 or more times per month, <1 time/month, never)

- 4. How often have you had erection/vaginal lubrication in the past 6 months/6 months before the onset of the renal disease? (Response alternatives: several times a week, 1 or more times per month, <1 time/month, never)
- 5. How often have you experienced difficulties in achieving an orgasm in the past 6 months/6 months before the onset of the renal disease? (Response alternatives: never/ rarely, sometimes, more than half of the times, always or almost always/not applicable)



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
