


Figure A1. Dynamic correlation of UFCI and CFCI.




Figure A2. Dynamic correlation of CFCI and CINF.




Figure A3. Dynamic correlation of UFCI and CINF.




Figure A4. Response of CINF to UFCI shock under different order of variables in the TVP-VAR-SV.
